Debbi Mack is the New York Times bestselling author of *Identity Crisis*, the first book in the Sam McRae Mystery Series, featuring Maryland lawyer-sleuth Stephanie Ann "Sam" McRae. The series includes four novels, which are being re-released. Currently, *Identity Crisis* is available in print, ebook, and audiobook format. The second book, Least Wanted, is available in print and ebook, with the audiobook in production. The third book, *Riptide*, and the fourth, *Deep Six*, are soon to be released.

Debbi has also written and published a young adult novel, *Invisible Me*, which was the solo "Medalist Winner" in the Young Adult Category for the 2016 New Apple Book Awards. The book is the first in a planned series of Portia Maddox novels. She's also published an adult standalone thriller novel entitled *The Planck Factor*.

Debbi is currently finishing work on a new series of novellas about a retired female Marine named Erica Jensen, who struggles with PTSD and an opioid addiction while trying to work as an unlicensed investigator.

Debbi has written and published several short stories. In 2010, her short story "The Right to Remain Silent" was nominated for a Derringer Award. Debbi has also self-published an anthology of her short stories called *Five Uneasy Pieces*.

Along with writing novels, Debbi has also written two feature film screenplays. Her first is called *The Enemy Within*, a crime thriller which made the Second Round in the 2014 Austin Film Festival screenplay contest and the 2016 Scriptapalooza semi-finals. The second is an adaptation of her first novel, which has been optioned by Lisa Tuvalo, a Maryland film producer. Debbi's short film script, "Murder Your Darlings" made the semi-finals in the 2018 Creative World Awards contest.
